If your child is unable to attend nursery, please let us know by 9:30am by calling: ☎ 01206 860467 or sending a message via WhatsApp.

Please avoid using Facebook or social media to report absences, as these are not checked until later in the day.

If your child has been sick or had diarrhoea, they must stay at home until 48 hours have passed since their last episode.

Please also remember not to give Calpol before nursery, as it can mask symptoms and temperatures.

Healthy Eating


Thank you for your continued support with healthy lunchboxes.
